

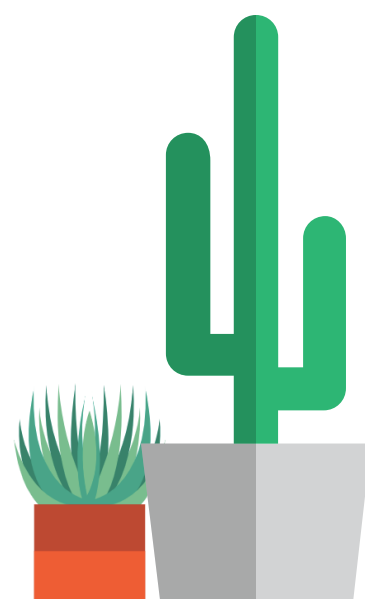

Joshua Tree National Park

Half Day

\$30 park entry per car.

Palm Springs Aerial Tramway

A Few Hours
